Now that we are back to Standard Time

- Beware around 4 -5 PM backroads of long tree shadows flickering on the road, this can be distracting.
- ➤ Tree leaves during the colder months indigenous trees drop their leaves on roads. Early mornings these can be wet and slippery.
- ➤ Sun Flare earlier Sunset you're driving down an unfamiliar road. You turn a sharp corner and are instantly blinded by the sun's sharp glare. The driver ahead of you slams on his brakes when faced with the same sudden sun blindness.
- Check air pressure in the colder months, your tire pressure can vary and can be under-inflated, Check before leaving, avoid uneven tire ware.
- Dress warmer the temps can suddenly drop in late afternoon, wear or pack layers
