

## **Tips and Common sense**

### **Now that we are back to Standard Time**

- **Beware around 4 -5 PM backroads of long tree shadows flickering on the road, this can be distracting.**
- **Tree leaves - during the colder months indigenous trees drop their leaves on roads. Early mornings these can be wet and slippery.**
- **Sun Flare – earlier Sunset - you're driving down an unfamiliar road. You turn a sharp corner and are instantly blinded by the sun's sharp glare. The driver ahead of you slams on his brakes when faced with the same sudden sun blindness.**
- **Check air pressure in the colder months, your tire pressure can vary and can be under-inflated, Check before leaving, avoid uneven tire wear.**
- **Dress warmer – the temps can suddenly drop in late afternoon, wear or pack layers**
