Tips For Riding a Motorcycle In The Rain



- Check the weather forecast and radar before starting your trip.
 - Also use free Phone apps like:
 - The Weather Channel (Android; iOS: Free) ...
 - WeatherBug (Android, iOS: Free)
 - **Carrot Weather** (Android, iOS: Free) ...
 - Emergency: Alerts (Android; iOS) ...
 - o Clime: NOAA Weather Radar Live (Android, iOS: Free) ...



 Always keep <u>reflective</u> rain gear on your bike and put it on before it starts raining!



- <u>Stay out of the middle of the lane</u>. That is where all the oil droppings are.
 - **NOTE** When it rains, the roads are actually the most slippery **the first 10 to 15 minutes** when the storm begins.



 Use <u>anti fog treatment</u> for the <u>inside</u> of your glasses and face shield. Use a rain repellant such as Rain-X (plastic ONLY!) for the <u>outside</u> of your glasses and face shield

- <u>Slow down</u> and increase your following distance. Use your brakes smoothly and gently. Use your Hazard flashers (*if necessary*), and Avoid using cruise control. <u>Be in Control</u>
- Never ride in a thunderstorm. Find shelter but not under a tree.
 - if you feel there is a risk of getting struck by lightning, you should immediately stop, and seek shelter and do not use your mobile phones



• Stay calm and relaxed as possible and make good decisions.



• Be alert as possible to the traffic /Trucks and road conditions around you.
