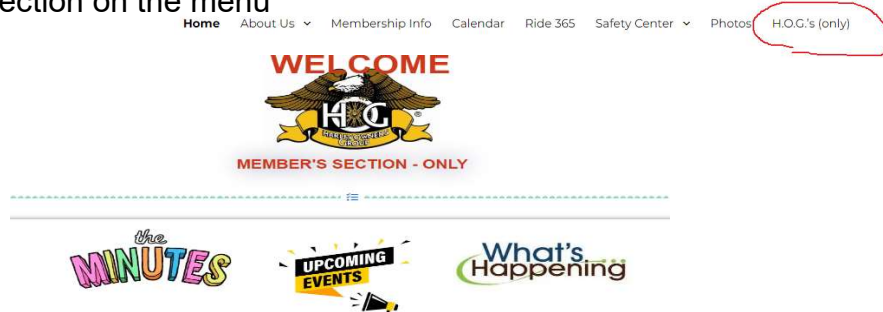
Treasurer – Fred Roberto

Safety Officer – Jeff Umstead –

STOP LIGHT POSITIONS,

At stop light intersections, stay in car tire track (off of center oil lane). I like to be in the left tire track in right hand lane and right tire track in left hand lane.

CARS AS SHIELDS

Leave enough space in front of you to move up between cars that are in front of you, if necessary. Use the cars as a shield/buffer in the event of a collision. **Keep your bike in gear**, ready for a fast move in an emergency.

REAR VIEW AWARENESS

Watch rear view mirrors and be ready to move if a vehicle is approaching too fast.
