Jeff asked to have an open group discussion on the past couple incidents

On what we could have done better? and what can we improve on? I.e. Group coordination, Communication, Site incidents control

The outcome of the discussion, ended up that everyone, including the members that were directly involved, on both incidents, felt that everyone did a role. Ensuring safety of the injured, taken care of each other, removing the bike from the road, cleaning up debris, traffic control, communication.

Also from the discussion, were some further thoughts

- Try not the leave a person riding by themselves (if possible)
  - always a good idea to ride with another person (buddy system)
- Carry the proper gear (tools, safety kit, lights/reflector)
- Try to wear the proper safety clothing (Helmet, padded jacket, jeans, gloves etc.)
- Participate in Safety Classes,
  - like what's coming up, a refresher course on <u>slow speed</u> and <u>safety riding</u> <u>skill</u> (Date <u>Sept 21<sup>st</sup> 9AM</u>)
  - More HOG sponsored classes, such as Accident Scene Management done in Jan 2024.
